I. OVERVIEW

- The Southwest monsoon (HABAGAT) will continue to bring moderate occasional to frequent rains over Luzon particularly along the provinces of Ilocos, La Union, Pangasinan, Zambales, Pampanga, Bataan and Bulacan today with gradual improvement of weather condition tomorrow and to the weekend.
- Threats of flashfloods and floods in low lying areas and landslides in mountainous areas as well as lahar flows over Pinatubo will gradually decrease. Residents living in those areas are still warned against the danger of these hazards that may occur.

PUBLIC WARNINGS:

People living near the mountain slopes and in the low lying areas as well as near the river systems in the affected areas and the local disaster risk reduction and management councils concerned are advised to be alert for possible flashfloods and landslides.

You are hereby directed to undertake precautionary measures and monitor the situation in your AOR. Likewise, the public and DRRMCs concerned are advised to take appropriate actions.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualties.
