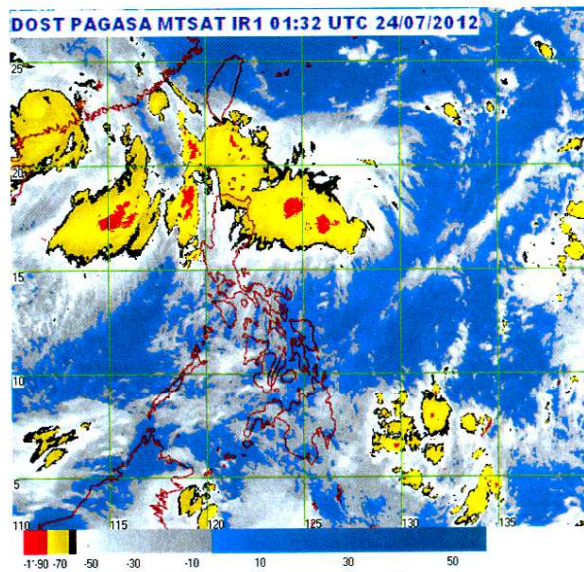

I. OVERVIEW

- At 11:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) East of Mindanao has remained almost stationary for the past six (6) hours and was estimated based on satellite and surface data at 910 kms East of Mindanao (7.0° N, 135.5°E).
- Meanwhile, a new Low Pressure Area (LPA) was spotted and based on satellite and surface data at 300 kms East of Tuguegarao (17.5° N, 125.0°E).
- These weather disturbances and the southwest monsoon will bring scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms over Northern and Central Luzon and Mindanao becoming widespread rains over Northern Luzon which may trigger flashfloods and landslides.



II. ACTION/S TAKEN

NDRRMC Weather Advisory No. 1 for Low Pressure Areas (LPAs) and Southwest Monsoon were disseminated to all OCD Regions through facsimile and website for further dissemination to their respective Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
