I. OVERVIEW

- At 8:00 AM today, the Active Low Pressure Area (ALPA) was estimated based on satellite, surface and radar data at 215 km east of General Santos City (6.0°N, 127.3°E). The Weather System will bring mostly cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms over Visayas and Mindanao becoming cloudy with widespread rains over Eastern and Southern Mindanao.
- Residents living in low lying areas and along mountain slopes are advised to be on alert for possible occurrence of flashfloods and landslides.

II. ACTION/S TAKEN
