#### **I. OVERVIEW**

- At 10:00 AM today, an Active Low Pressure Area (ALPA) was estimated based on satellite and surface data at 1,280 km east of Mindanao (6.9° N, 139.1°E) this weather disturbance is expected to enter the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) tomorrow morning and will affect eastern Visayas and eastern Mindanao by tomorrow evening.
- Residents living in low lying areas and along mountain slopes are advised to be on alert for possible occurrence of flashfloods and landslides.

#### **II. ACTION/S TAKEN**
