I. OVERVIEW

- At 8AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on satellite and surface data at 1,710 km East of Northern Luzon (17.7°N, 140.4°E). It is still too far to affect any part of the country.
- Meanwhile, the Southwest Monsoon will continue to bring scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms over Luzon and Western Visayas becoming widespread rains over Western Luzon which may continue to trigger flashfloods and landslides.

II. ACTION/S TAKEN

NDRRMC Weather Advisory No. 1 Low Pressure Areas (LPAs) and Southwest Monsoon was disseminated to all OCD Regions through facsimile and website for further dissemination to their respective Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
