I. OVERVIEW

- At 10:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated at 325 km east of Hinatuan City (8.3° N, 129.5° E). The LPA is expected to bring moderate to heavy rains (5.0-10.0 mm/hr) and thunderstorms in Mindanao particularly over the provinces of Agusan, Surigao, Davao, Compostela Valley and Zamboanga.
- Meanwhile, the Southwest Monsoon enhanced by Typhoon "IGME" will still bring moderate to heavy rains (3.0-15.0 mm/hr) with strong winds in the provinces of Ilocos, La Union, Abra, Benguet, Pangasinan, Zambales and Bataan which may trigger flashfloods and landslides.

II. ACTION/S TAKEN
