- I. OVERVIEW
 - At 8:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated at 370 km east of Legazpi City (13.0°N, 127.5°E). The LPA is expected to bring moderate to heavy rains (2.5-15.0 mm/hr) and thunderstorms in Southern Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao particularly over Bicol Region, Bukidnon, Antique, Iloilo and the Provinces of Samar, Leyte, Agusan, Misamis, Surigao and Lanao which may trigger flashfloods and landslides.

II. ACTION/S TAKEN

 NDRRMC Weather Advisory No. 1 for Low Pressure Area was disseminated to all OCD Regions through facsimile and website for further dissemination to their respective Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
