I. OVERVIEW

- At 8:00 AM today, the Active Low Pressure Area (ALPA) was estimated based on satellite and surface data at 355 km East of Apari, Cagayan (18.5°N, 125.6°E).
- This weather disturbance will bring scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms in Northern and Central Luzon becoming widespread rains over Cagayan, Isabela, Quirino and Aurora which may trigger flashfloods and landslides.

II. ACTION/S TAKEN

NDRRMC Weather Advisory No. 1 for Active Low Pressure Area was disseminated to all OCD Regions through facsimile and website for further dissemination to their respective Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
