I. OVERVIEW

- **At 8AM today, The Low pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on satellite and surface data at 580 KM East of Hinatuan City, Surigao Del Sur (8.5°N, 132.0°E). This weather disturbance will affect eastern Visayas and eastern Mindanao**
- Residents living in low lying areas and along mountain slopes are advised to be on alert for possible occurrence of flashfloods and landslides.

II. ACTION/S TAKEN
