#### I. OVERVIEW

- At 8:00 PM today, the Active Low Pressure Area (ALPA) was estimated based on satellite, surface and radar data in the vicinity of Samal Island, Davao (6.5°N, 125.8°E). This weather system will bring cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms over Mindanao.
- Residents living in low lying areas and along mountain slopes are advised to be on alert for possible occurrence of flashfloods and landslides.
