I. OVERVIEW

At 10:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated at 510 KM Northeast of Guiuan, Eastern Samar (13.9°N, 130.0°E). The LPA and Southwest Monsoon are expected to bring light to moderate rains (1.0-5.0 mm/hr) and thunderstorms in Luzon and Visayas becoming moderate to heavy rains (5-10 mm/hr) over Panay and the provinces of Mindoro and Negros which may trigger flashfloods and landslides.

II. ACTION/S TAKEN
