I. OVERVIEW

At 10:00 am today, the Active Low Pressure Area (ALPA) was estimated based on satellite and surface data at 350 km east of Southern Mindanao (6.0°N, 129.0°E). This weather system will bring cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms over Southern Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao becoming widespread rains over Visayas and Mindanao.

Residents living in low lying areas and along mountain slopes are advised to be on alert for possible occurrence of flashfloods and landslides.

II. ACTION/S TAKEN
