I. OVERVIEW

- The Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on satellite and surface data at 380 km east of Hinatuan City, Surigao del Sur (8.8 deg N, 130.0 deg E). The other Low Pressure Area was estimated at 350 km North Northeast of Basco, Batanes (23.8N. 123.9E)

The Low Pressure Area East of Hinatuan City will continue to bring scattered to widespread rains and thunderstorms over Eastern Visayas and Mindanao which may trigger flash floods and landslides.

II. ACTION/S TAKEN

- NDRRMC Weather Advisory No. 3 Low Pressure Area (LPA) was disseminated to all OCD Regions through facsimile and website for further dissemination to their respective Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels
