I. OVERVIEW

- At 8:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on satellite, surface and radar data to be at 70 km West of Davao City (7.0°N, 125.0°E). This weather system will bring cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms over Eastern Visayas and Mindanao.
- Residents living in low lying areas and along mountain slopes are advised to be on alert for possible occurrence of flashfloods and landslides.
