





I. OVERVIEW

Light to moderate rains (1.0 to 5.0 mm/hr) were observed with no possible flashfloods and landslides in the western section of Luzon. However, scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms will continue to affect Luzon and Visayas due to the Southwest Monsoon.

With this development, this is the final advisory.
