I. OVERVIEW

Light to moderate rains (1.0 to 5.0 mm/hr) were observed in the past few hours. Threat of flashfloods is reduced but possibility of landslides remain especially in mountain slopes which experienced frequent and moderate to heavy rains during the past few days in the western section of Luzon. However, scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms will continue to affect Luzon and Visayas due to the Southwest Monsoon.

II. ACTION/S TAKEN

NDRRMC Weather Advisory No. 3 (AMENDMENT) for Southwest Monsoon was disseminated to all OCD Regions through facsimile and website for further dissemination to their respective Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
