## I. OVERVIEW

- At 11:00 AM today, The effect of the Southwest Monsoon has weakened but it still expected to bring scattered Light to Moderate rains(1.0-5.0 mm/hr) and thunderstorms over the western section of southern Luzon.
- Meanwhile, the Shallow Low Pressure Area(SLPA) has dissipated.
