I. OVERVIEW

- At 8PM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on satellite and surface data at 20 KM Southeast of Alabat, Quezon (13.8°N, 122.2°E).
- This weather disturbance is expected to bring scattered to widespread rains over southern Luzon including National Capital Region.
- Residents living in low lying areas and along mountain slopes are advised to be on alert for possible occurrence of flashfloods and landslides.

II. ACTION/S TAKEN
