I. OVERVIEW

At 10:00 am today, the Low Pressure Area (ALPA) was estimated based on satellite and surface data at 130 km east of Davao City (7.0°N, 126.8°E). This weather system will bring cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms over Southern Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao becoming widespread rains over Bicol Region, Eastern and Central Visayas and Northern and Eastern Mindanao.

Residents living in low lying areas and along mountain slopes are advised to be on alert for possible occurrence of flashfloods and landslides.
