I. OVERVIEW

- At 8:00 a.m. today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on satellite and surface data at 210 km East Southeast of Puerto Prinsesa City (9.1°N, 120.7°E). This weather system will bring cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms over Palawan while Western Visayas will have mostly cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms.
- Residents living in low lying areas and along mountain slopes are advised to be on alert for possible occurrence of flashfloods and landslides.
