#### I. OVERVIEW

- At 8 a.m. today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on satellite and surface data at 60 km Northwest of Ambulong, Batangas or 50 km West Southwest of Manila (14.3°N, 120.5°E).
- This weather disturbance is expected to bring scattered to widespread rains over Central and Southern Luzon including National Capital Region (NCR), and Western Visayas.
- Residents living in low lying areas and along mountain slopes are advised to be on alert for possible occurrence of flashfloods and landslides.

### II. ACTION/S TAKEN
