#### **I. OVERVIEW**

- At 8 a.m. today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on satellite and surface data at 150 km West Northwest of Iba, Zambales (15.8°N, 118.5°E).
- This weather disturbance is expected to bring scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms in the Northern and Central Luzon becoming widespread rains over western section of Central Luzon.
- Residents living in low lying areas and along mountain slopes are advised to be on alert for possible occurrence of flashfloods and landslides.

#### **II. ACTION/S TAKEN**

**NDRRMC Weather Advisory No. 6 for Low Pressure Area (LPA)** was disseminated to all OCD Regions through facsimile and website for further dissemination to their respective Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels .
