I. OVERVIEW

- At 8:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on satellite and surface data at 440 km West of Calapan, Oriental Mindoro (13.7°N, 116.8°E) embedded along the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ).
- The weather condition has improved for the past 12 hours and it is expected to have mostly cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms over the western section of Southern Luzon.
