I. OVERVIEW

- The Southwest Monsoon (Habagat) has weakened but will continue to bring mostly cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms over Northern and Central Luzon particularly along the provinces of Ilocos, La Union, Pangasinan, Zambales, Pampanga, Bataan, Tarlac and Bulacan.
- Meanwhile, at 10:00 AM, the low pressure area has become active and was
 estimated at 1,280 km East of Central Luzon (15.2°N, 135.5°E) and still too
 far to affect any part of the country within the next 24 hours.

II. ACTION/S TAKEN

NDRRMC Weather Advisory No. 9 (Final) for Southwest Monsoon was disseminated to all OCD Regions through facsimile and website for further dissemination to their respective Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
