Overview:

- ❖ "INDAY" (FANAPI) has intensified into a Typhoon as it moves North Northeastward.

Location of eye/center (as of 10:00 PM)	660 km East Northeast of Basco, Batanes
Coordinates	22.0°N, 128.5 °E
Strength	Maximum sustained winds of 120 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 150 kph
Movement:	Forecast to move North Northeast at 7 kph
Forecast Positions	700 km northeast of Basco, Batanes by tomorrow evening and at 500 km North Northeast of Basco, Batanes by Saturday evening. By Sunday evening, it will be at 500 km North of Basco, Batanes

- ❖ The public and the disaster coordinating councils concerned are advised to take appropriate action

You are hereby directed to undertake precautionary measures in your AOR. Likewise, the public and Disaster Coordinating Councils (DCCs) concerned are advised to take appropriate actions.

Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.
