Overview:

- ❖ **Typhoon "INDAY" (FANAPI) has intensified slightly as it continues to move northward slowly**

Location of eye/center (as of 10:00 AM)	660 km East Northeast of Basco, Batanes
Coordinates	22.5°N, 128.3 °E
Strength	Maximum sustained winds of 130 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 160 kph
Movement:	Forecast to move North at 5 kph
Forecast Positions	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 650 km East Northeast of Basco, Batanes by tomorrow morning• 487 km Northeast of Basco, Batanes by Sunday morning• 365 km North of Basco, Batanes or 110 km South Southeast of Taipei

- ❖ The public and the disaster coordinating councils concerned are advised to take appropriate action

Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.
