Reference: PAGASA SWB No. 6 Tropical Cyclone Alert: TY "INDAY" (FANAPI) issued at 10:00 PM, 17 Sept 2010

Overview:

Typhoon "INDAY" (FANAPI) has intensified further as it moves northwestward.

Location of eye/center (as of 10:00 PM)	620 km East Northeast of Basco, Batanes
Coordinates	23.3°N, 127.7 °E
Strength	Maximum sustained winds of 140 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 170 kph
Movement:	Forecast to move Northwest at 7 kph
Forecast Positions	 520 km Northeast of Basco, Batanes by tomorrow evening 390 km North Northeast of Basco, Batanes by Sunday evening 490 km North Northwest of Basco, Batanes or 190 km West Southwest of Taipei, Taiwan by Monday evening

The public and the disaster coordinating councils concerned are advised to take appropriate action

You are hereby directed to undertake precautionary measures in your AOR. Likewise, the public and Disaster Coordinating Councils (DCCs) concerned are advised to take appropriate actions.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let us untiringly aim for zero casualties.
