

#### 1. Overview:

- ❖ The Active Low Pressure Area (ALPA) east of Northern Luzon has developed into a Tropical Depression and was named "Inday".

Location of eye/center (as of 10:00 AM)	640kms east of Basco, Batanes
Coordinates	20.1°N, 128.5 °E
Strength	Maximum winds of 55 kph near the center
Movement:	Forecast to move west northwest at 11kph
Forecast Positions	420 km east northeast of Basco, Batanes by tomorrow morning and at 290km north northeast of Basco, Batanes by Friday morning. By Saturday morning, it will be at 370km north of Basco, Batanes

- ❖ Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) will continue to affect and bring scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms over Southern Luzon and Visayas
- ❖ The public and the disaster coordinating councils concerned are advised to take appropriate action
