

#### 1. Overview:

- ❖ Tropical Storm "Inday" (FANAPI) has intensified further as it moves northward.

Location of eye/center (as of 10:00 AM)	590 km East Northeast of Basco, Batanes
Coordinates	21.6°N, 127.9 °E
Strength	Maximum sustained winds of 85 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 100 kph
Movement:	Forecast to move North at 7 kph
Forecast Positions	610 km east northeast of Basco, Batanes by tomorrow morning and at 560 km North Northeast of Basco, Batanes by Saturday morning. By Sunday morning, it will be at 510 km North Northeast of Basco, Batanes
