## SITUATION OVERVIEW

An armed conflict occurred in Cotabato Province on October 6, 2010 affecting six (6) barangays in four (4) municipalities namely: Kabacan, President Roxas, Magpet and Pikit

A total of 1,042 families or 5,726 persons were affected/displaced and at the same time evacuated to Municipal Gymnasium, Brgy Hall/Center and house base with relatives and friends from nearby municipalities
