

I. OVERVIEW:

Tropical Depression "KATRING" has maintained its strength as it remains quasi-stationary over the Philippine sea.



Location of Center: (as of 10:00 AM)	1,110 km East of Quezon Province
Coordinates:	14.7°N, 132.7°E
Strength:	Maximum winds of 55 kph near the center

Movement:	Forecast to remain quasi-stationary
Forecast Positions/Outlook:	<i>Monday morning:</i> 940 km Quezon Province <i>Tuesday morning:</i> 660 km East Northeast of Quezon <i>Wednesday morning:</i> 310 km East of Northern Luzon

2. ACTIONS TAKEN:

NDRRMC **Severe Weather Bulletin No. 03 re Tropical Depression “KATRING”** was disseminated to all OCD Regional Centers through SMS and facsimile; and uploaded into the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local disaster risk reduction and management councils from the provincial down to the municipal levels.

RDRRMCs through the OCD Regional Centers were directed to undertake precautionary measures in their AOR. Likewise, the public and Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (DRRMCs) were advised to take appropriate precautionary measures such as pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying areas and near mountain slopes as necessary.
