

#### I. OVERVIEW:

"KATRING" has intensified into a Typhoon as it continues to move to a North Northwestward direction.



<b>Location of Center:</b> (as of 10:00 AM)	700 km East of Southeast of extreme Northern Luzon
<b>Coordinates:</b>	19.7°N, 129.2°E
<b>Strength:</b>	Maximum winds of 120 kph near the center gustiness of up to 150 kph
<b>Movement:</b>	North Northwest at 11 kph

<b>Forecast Positions/Outlook:</b>	<i>Wednesday Morning</i>
	630 km East Northeast of extreme Northern Luzon
	<i>Thursday Morning</i>
	670 km Northeast of extreme Northern Luzon
	<i>Friday Morning</i>
	910 km Northeast of extreme Northern Luzon

## 2. ACTIONS TAKEN:

NDRRMC **Severe Weather Bulletin No. 07 re Typhoon "KATRING" (CHABA)** was disseminated to all OCD Regional Centers through SMS and facsimile; and uploaded into the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local disaster risk reduction and management councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels.

Regional Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (RDRRMCs) through the OCD Regional Centers were directed to undertake precautionary measures in their AOR. Likewise, the public and Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (DRRMCs) were advised to take appropriate precautionary measures such as pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying areas and near mountain slopes as necessary.
