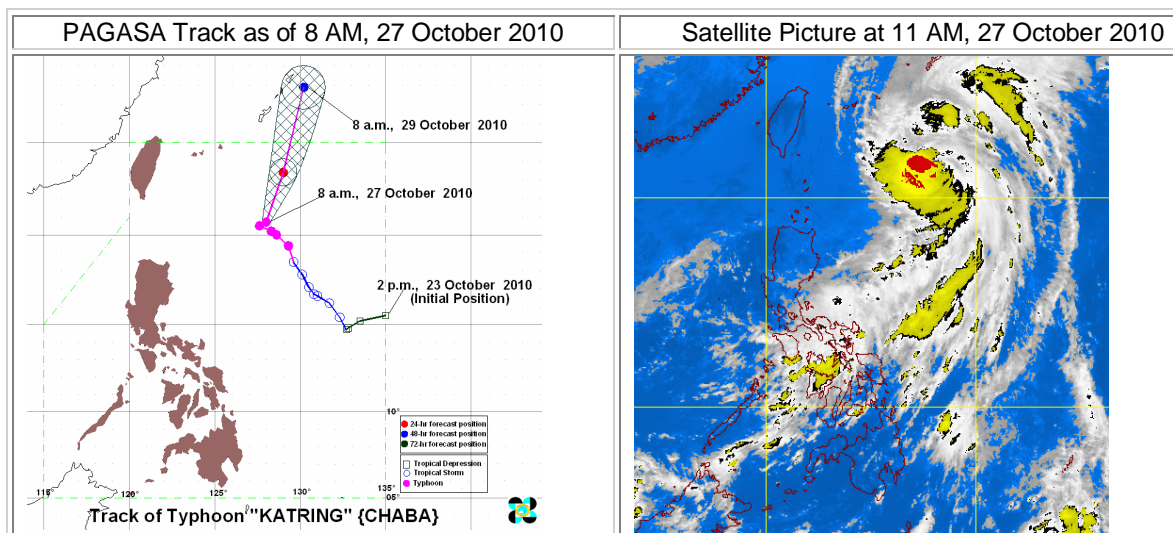

I. OVERVIEW:

"KATRING" has maintained its strength and continues to move away from the country.

Strength:	Maximum winds of 120 kph near the center gustiness of up to 150 kph
Movement:	North at 9 kph
Forecast Positions/Outlook:	<i>Thursday morning:</i> 740 km East Northeast of Extreme Northern Luzon <i>Friday morning:</i> 1070 km Northeast of Extreme Northern Luzon


