1. OVERVIEW:

- The combined effect of Northeast Monsoon (Amihan) and tail-end of a cold front over Luzon and Visayas. These weather systems will bring cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms over Southern Luzon and Visayas becoming widespread rains over Bicol Region and Samar provinces which may trigger flashfloods and landslides.
- Fishermen in Luzon and Eastern Visayas are advised not to venture out into the sea due to big waves generated by strong to gale force northeasterly winds

2. ACTIONS TAKEN:
