1. OVERVIEW:

- The combined effect of Northeast Monsoon (Amihan) and tail-end of a cold front over the whole country will bring mostly cloudy skies with light rains over Northern and Central Luzon while cloudy skies with scattered to widespread rains over Southern Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao which may trigger flashfloods and landslides.
- Fishermen in Luzon, Visayas and Northern Mindanao are advised not to venture out into the sea due to big waves generated by strong to gale force northeasterly winds

2. ACTIONS TAKEN:

- NDRRMC Weather Advisory No. 14 for Northeast Monsoon and Tail-End of a Cold Front was disseminated to all regions concerned through facsimile and website for further dissemination to their respective Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels
