1. OVERVIEW:

- The interaction of northeast windflow (amihan) and the easterlies enhanced by La Nina will continue to bring mostly cloudy skies with light rains over western section of northern and central Luzon while the rest of Luzon and the eastern section of Visayas and the whole of Mindanao will be cloudy skies with scattered to widespread rains which may trigger flashfloods and landslides. The rest of Visayas will be partly cloudy to cloudy with isolated rainshowers and thunderstorms.
- Fishermen in Luzon, Visayas and Northern Mindanao are advised not to venture out into the sea due to big waves generated by strong to gale force northeasterly winds
