1. OVERVIEW:

- Northeast Monsoon (Amihan) associated with light rains and cooler temperature prevails over Luzon particularly over the eastern section while tail-end of a cold front is affecting Visayas and Mindanao that brings cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms becoming widespread rains over Eastern Visayas, Northern and Eastern Mindanao which may trigger flashfloods and landslides.
- Fishermen in Luzon, Visayas, including Northern and Eastern Mindanao are advised not to venture out into the sea due to big waves generated by moderate to strong northeasterly winds

2. ACTIONS TAKEN:
