1. OVERVIEW:

- Northeast Monsoon associated with dry and cold weather condition with moderate to strong winds affecting Central and Northern Luzon.
 Fishermen along these areas are advised not to venture out into the sea due to big waves generated by strong Northeasterly Winds
- Wind Convergence will affect Southern Luzon, Eastern Visayas and Northeastern Mindanao. This weather system will bring scattered to widespread rains particularly Bicol area and Eastern Visayas. Residents living in low-lying areas are advised to take all the necessary measures against possible flashfloods and landslides

2. ACTIONS TAKEN:
