1. OVERVIEW:

WEATHER ADVISORY NO. 03 –

- Northeast Monsoon (Amihan) associated with light rains and cooler temperature will continue to prevail over Northern and Central Luzon particularly over the eastern section while diffused tail-end of a cold front °scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms.
- Fishermen in Luzon and Visayas are advised not to venture out into the sea due to big waves generated by moderate to strong Northeasterly Winds.

SPECIAL WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR METRO MANILA –

- The tail-end of a cold front will affect Metro Manila this coming Sunday (Jan 9, 2011). This weather condition will bring mostly cloudy skies with light rains over Metro Manila. Temperature will range from 19-30°C.
- This outlook will be updated as soon as significant changes in the weather pattern occur.

2. ACTIONS TAKEN:
