### 1. OVERVIEW:

- Northeast Monsoon (Amihan) associated with strong Northeasterly Winds with light rains and cooler temperature will prevail over Luzon. Fishermen along these areas are advised not to venture out into the sea due to big waves generated by strong Northeasterly winds
- Tail-end of a cold front affect Visayas and Mindanao that will bring cloudy skies with rainshowers and thunderstorms becoming widespread rains over the eastern sections Visayas and Mindanao which may trigger flashfloods and landslides

### 2. ACTIONS TAKEN:

NDRRMC Weather Advisory No. **04** for Northeast Monsoon and Tail-End of a Cold Front was disseminated to all regions concerned through facsimile and website for further dissemination to their respective Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
