1. OVERVIEW:

- Northeast Monsoon (Amihan) associated with light rains and cooler temperature will prevail over Luzon while tail-end of a cold front will affect Visayas and Mindanao that will bring cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms becoming widespread rains over the eastern Visayas and northeastern Mindanao which may trigger flashfloods and landslides
- Fishermen in Luzon and Visayas are advised not to venture out into the sea due to big waves generated by strong northeasterly winds

2. ACTIONS TAKEN:

NDRRMC Weather Advisory No. **05** for Northeast Monsoon and Tail-End of a Cold Front was disseminated to all regions concerned through facsimile and website for further dissemination to their respective Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
