1. OVERVIEW:

- Northeast Monsoon (Amihan) associated with light rains and cooler air prevails over Luzon while diffused tail-end of a cold front affects Southern Luzon and Visayas that will bring cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms becoming widespread rains over eastern Visayas which may trigger flashfloods and landslides..
- Fishermen in Luzon and Visayas are advised not to venture out into the sea due to big waves generated by strong to gale force northeasterly winds.

2. ACTIONS TAKEN:

NDRRMC Weather Advisory No. **06** for Northeast Monsoon and Tail-End of a Cold Front was disseminated to all regions concerned through facsimile and website for further dissemination to their respective Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
