1. OVERVIEW:

- The combined effect of the Northeast Monsoon (Amihan) and the Tail-end of a Cold Front will continue to affect Luzon and Visayas. These weather systems will bring scattered rainshowers and isolated thunderstorms over the Northern and Central Luzon. The eastern section of southern Luzon and the whole of Visayas becoming widespread rains over the provinces of Quezon, Camarines Provinces, Catanduanes, Albay, Sorsogon, Samar and Leyte Provinces
- Residents in low-lying areas are advised to take appropriate actions against possible flashfloods and landslides
- Fishermen in Luzon, Visayas and Northern Mindanao are advised not to venture out into the sea due to big waves generated by strong to gale force northeasterly winds

2. ACTIONS TAKEN:
