1. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

a) Maritime Incident in Oriental Mindoro (Region IV-B)

- ❖ A Cargo passenger named "MB Dominic ",owned by Mr Ricky Lavega capsized at 10 miles off Burungcaan Point near Brgy Milagros, Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro
- ❖ Said motorboat came from Brgy Caminawit going to Caluya Island, Antique with 10 crew and five (5) passengers on board and was rescued at 3:00 PM by a tugboat named MB Roxanne from Semirara Island
- Passengers were reported safe and were brought by PCG in Caluya, Semirara Island, Antique. They are identified as: <u>Boat Captain</u> Christoper Genevacio; <u>Crew</u>: Alvin de los Angeles; Ricky Leuterio; Jojo Silerio; Ruben Castaňeda; Jaypee Erodias; Danny Dagohoy; Jonly Ysug; Jeson Policarpio; and Mark Centeno; and Passengers: Elpenor Sino; Lulia Solibio; Mary Rose Solibio; and Carlyn Baltazar
- One (1) person, identified as Ma Nida Peña, was reported dead and her body was brought back to Caminawit, San Jose, Occidental Mindoro by her relative

b) Whirlwind and Storm Surge in Sarangani Province (Region XII)

- On or about 1:00AM, 22 February 2011, whirlwind and storm surge incidents occurred in Brgy. Pangyan and Brgy. Burias, Glan, Sarangani due to continuous heavy rains
- One hundred forty eight (148) families/740 persons were affected and they were evacuated to two (2) schools utilized as evacuation centers: 5 families/25 persons from Brgy Pangyan and 143 families/715 persons from Brgy Burias
- One (1) house was partially damaged and 4 totally damaged in Brgy Pangyan and 143 houses were damaged in Brgy Burias

c) Vehicular Accident in Sablan, Benguet (CAR)

❖ A Toyota Land Cruiser bearing plate number RAD-836, bound for Baguio City accidentally fell on a 200 meters deep ravine on Feb 25, 2011 at 7:45 AM at Sitio Kalipkip. Banangan, Sablan, Benguet One (1) fatality was identified as Bernie Opiniano 29 yrs old of 159 Upper Quezon Hill, Baguio City (driver)

2. ACTIONS TAKEN

a) Region IV-B

Coordinated with PNP-PPO Occidental Mindoro; MARINA; PCG District Southern Tagalog, PDRRMC Occidental Mindoro, OCD Region VI PCG Antique, Aklan and the Municipal Mayor of Caluya, Antique, Geneviva Lim on the status of search and rescue operations in Antique

b) Region XII

- ❖ The LDRRMCs alerted their constituents to secure themselves from any adverse conditions caused by heavy rain prior to the incident
- ❖ The Sangguniang Bayan passed a resolution declaring the entire municipality of Glan under a State of Calamity
- PDRRMC Sarangani and MDRRMC Glan conducted damage and needs assessment in affected barangays
- ❖ MDRRMC Glan, Sarangani provided 100 sacks of rice and 7,000 food packs to the affected families in Brgys Pangyan and Burias

c) CAR

- Emergency responders that responded to the disaster scene were Sablan Municipal Police Station; Baguio City Emergency; BFP Sablan, Benguet; BFP Baguio City; BBPICAG; OCD CAR; and concerned citizens
- The cadaver was brought to the nearest funeral parlor
- ❖ OCD CAR assisted the LGU in implementing the Incident Command System during the rescue and retrieval operations
