SITUATION OVERVIEW:

Profile of the Incident

- A fire of still undetermined cause broke out at Ext. A. Leongson St., corner Gov. Pascual St., Brgy. San Roque, Navotas City on or about 11:08 PM, 29 January 2011
- The fire reached up to alarm level TF Alpha and was put under control at around 02:00 AM, 30 January 2011. Said fire was declared fire-out at 4:45 AM, 30 January 2011

Affected Population/Houses

 A total of more or less 100 houses made of light and semi-concrete materials were burned affecting 366 families or approximately 1,830 persons. Currently, affected families are housed at San Roque National High School and Adela Chapel

Casualties

 Nine (9) of the 12 dead victims were brought to the Thadean Funeral Homes along Brgy. Daang Hari, Navotas City. Names of the 12 dead victims are the following:

- The two (2) injured persons are still unidentified
- The estimated cost of damages was placed at Php 5,000,000.00

Actions Taken

- Responding Agencies/Teams were the BFP CAMANAVA (Caloocan, Malabon, Navotas, and Valenzuela), BFP Manila City, BFP Quezon City, DSWD Navotas City, Brgy San Roque, CDAG, and other Filipino-Chinese Fire Volunteers with more or less 89 fire trucks, 80 volunteers and 8 ambulances
- OCD Operations Center coordinated with the Armed Forces of the Philippines thru J3 for the availability of one (1) 6x6 Military Truck which transported relief goods from DSWD-NROC, Pasay City to Navotas City.
- Brgy. San Roque Officials provided security assistance to the fire victims
- DSWD-NCR and DSWD-Navotas City jointly conducted an assessment to determine the exact number of fire victims and identified the needs/ requirements. Food assistance has been provided
- Health Response Team of Brgy. San Roque provided medical attention to the two (2) injured victims
