



SITUATION OVERVIEW

1. Armed Conflict in Kabacan, Cotabato:

- ❖ 1,262 families with 7,579 dependents were affected by the tension between MILF and MNLF arising from land conflict in the area and evacuated to the identified evacuation area by PDRRMC Cotabato Province.

2. Actions Taken:

- ❖ Measles mop up activities in the affected IDP sites
