I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

TSUNAMI ALERT LEVEL 2 NO EVACUATION ORDER

A strong local earthquake occurred in Negros Occidental at 11:49 AM (Philippine Time), located at 9.82N, 123.31E with depth of 10 km and a preliminary magnitude of 6.9Mb.

PHIVOLCS TSUNAMI ALERT LEVEL is now 2. NO EVACUATION ORDER IS IN EFFECT.

People in threatened coastal areas along Negros and Cebu Islands are expected to experience minor sea level changes and people living near coastal areas are advised to be watchful.

II. ACTIONS TAKEN:
