I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

TSUNAMI ALERT LEVEL 2 BE ON ALERT for UNUSUAL WAVES

A strong local earthquake occurred in Negros Oriental at 11:49 AM (Philippine Time), located at 9.97°N, 123.14°E with depth of 10 km and a preliminary magnitude of 6.9.

PHIVOLCS TSUNAMI ALERT LEVEL is now 2. The concerned public is advised to BE ON ALERT FOR UNUSUAL WAVES.

People advised to stay away from the shoreline. People should not go to coast to watch the tsunami. People whose houses are very near coastal areas of Negros and Cebu Islands are strongly advised to be watchful.
