I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

TSUNAMI ALERT LEVEL 0 NO EVACUATION ORDER

A strong teleseismic earthquake occurred in the Near the Coast of Chiapas, Mexico at 6:15 AM (Philippine Time), located at 14.3° S, 92.2° W with depth of 31 km and a preliminary magnitude of 6.6. No destructive Pacific-wide threat exists based on the historical and tsunami data. However, earthquakes of this size sometimes generate local tsunamis that can be destructive along coast located within hundred kilometers of this epicenter.

PHIVOLCS Tsunami ALERT Level is 0.

This is for information purposes only and there is no tsunami threat to the Philippines from this earthquake.

II. ACTIONS TAKEN:
