#### **I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:**

#### **TSUNAMI ALERT LEVEL 0 NO EVACUATION ORDER**

A strong earthquake occurred in **New Ireland Region, Papua New Guinea** at **4:04 AM** (Philippine Time), located at **4.7° South, 153.2° East** with a depth of **71 km** and a **preliminary magnitude of 6.6**. No destructive Pacific-wide threat exists based on the historical and tsunami data. However, earthquakes of this size sometimes generate local tsunamis that can be destructive along coasts located within a hundred kilometers of the epicenter.

#### **PHIVOLCS Tsunami ALERT Level is 0.**

This is for information purposes only and there is no tsunami threat to the Philippines from this earthquake.
